To Year 6, good luck and all the best for High School; you will be missed!

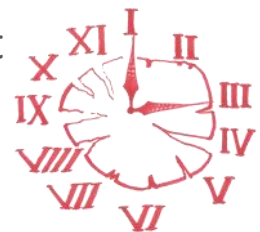
