The yeti turns around and makes a weird, shrieking sound, and then it falls out of the bath, and flops around on the ground for a bit. It crawls away and hides under the sink.....

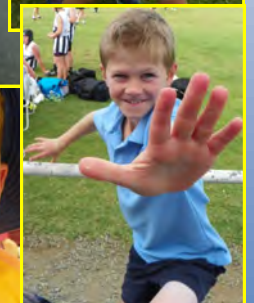
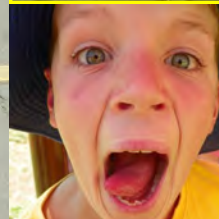
