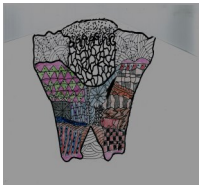
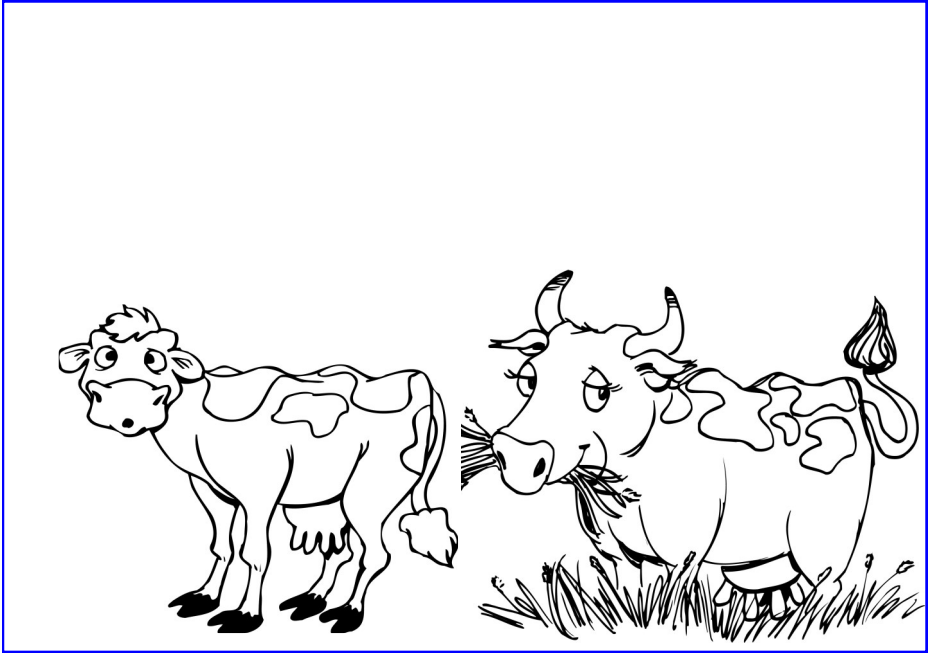

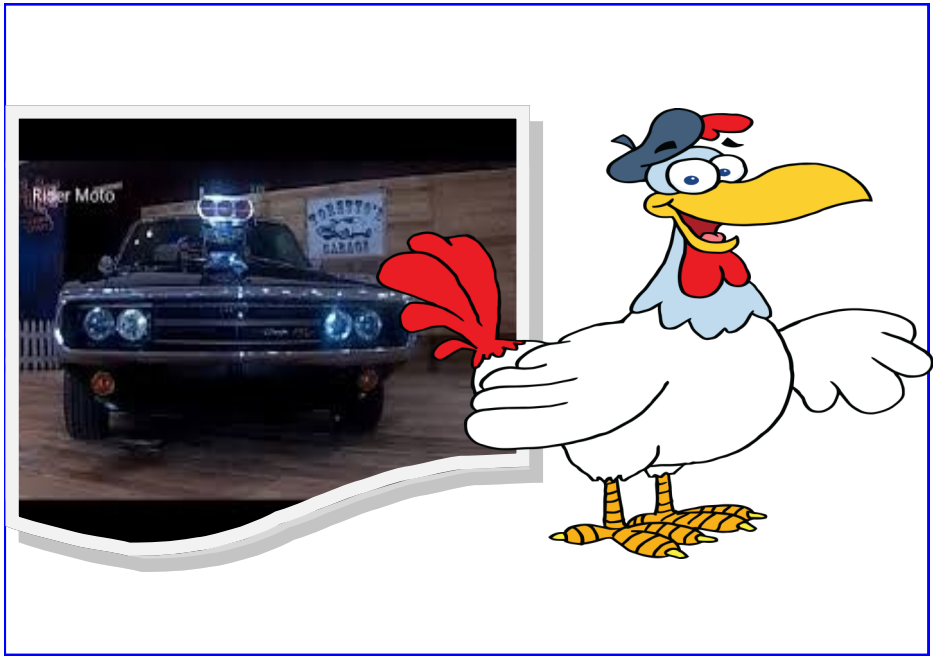

So, they contacted Roger the Dodger (if you don't know who Roger the Dodger is he has the quickest draw of the Wild West).



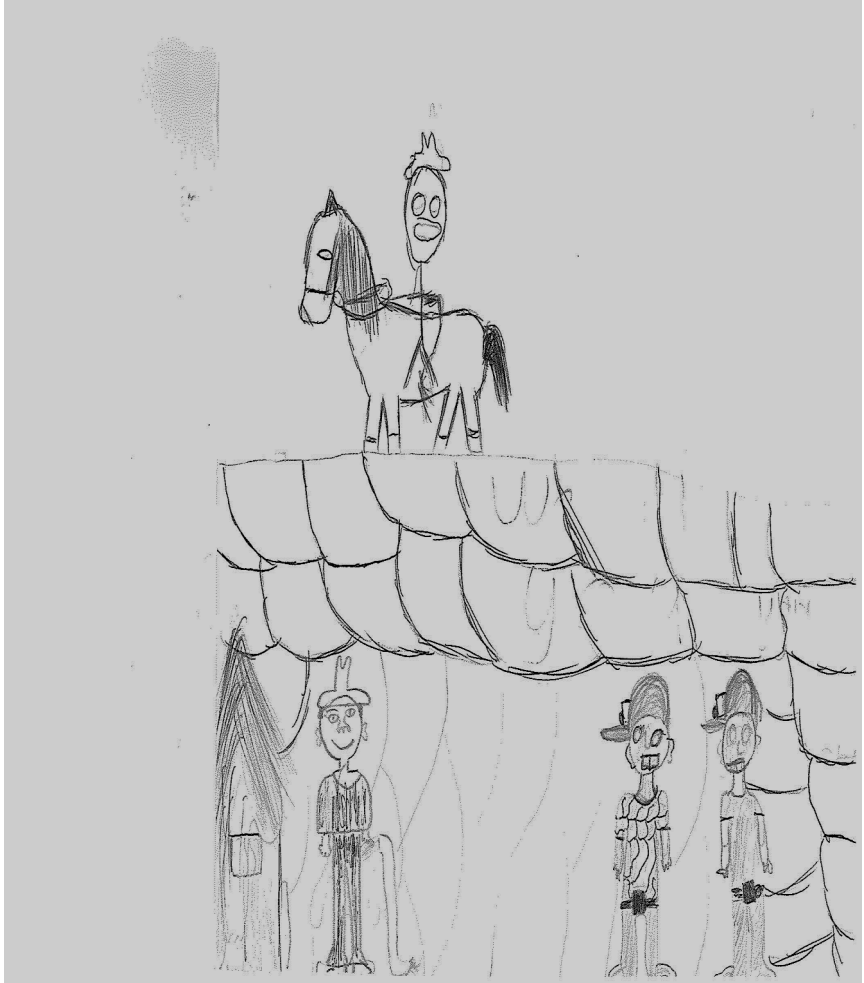
Roger the Dodger and his horse, Dusty, took off like bullets to go and meet up with the two slaves.



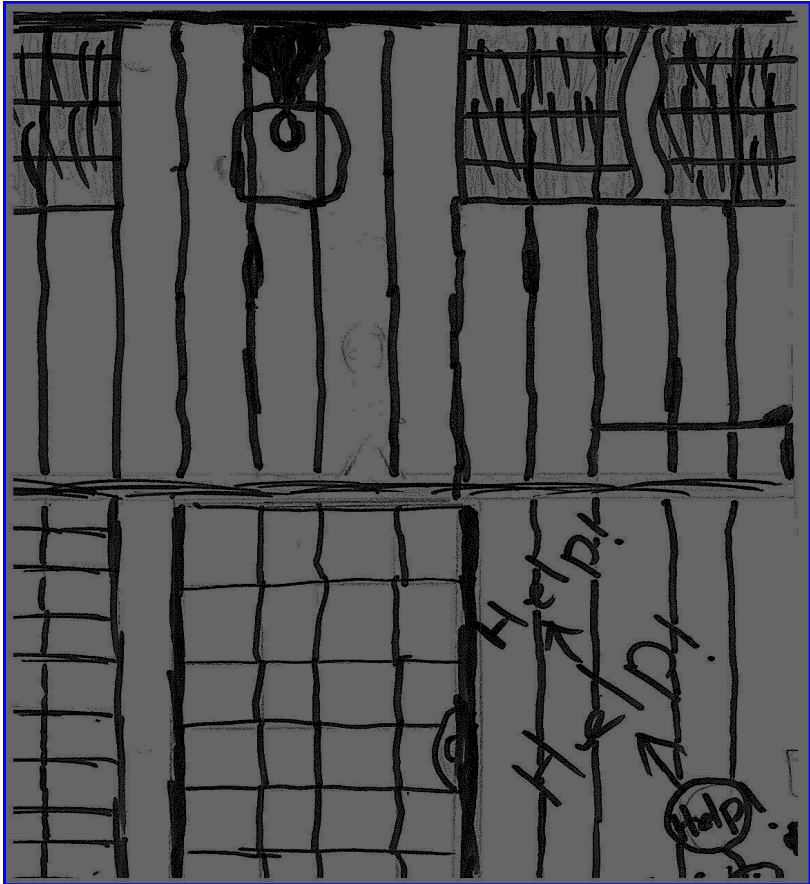

After they stole fifteen steers, the two slaves said to Wicked Cowboy, "Ha, ha, ha! We got you!"

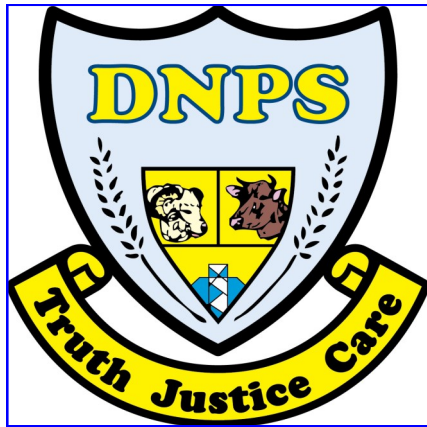


They took the film to Rodger the dodger who took it to the mayor. A day later Wicked Cowboy was arrested.
