
After hours of explaining, the mermaid asked why princess Ruby


that she trusted. She said that she trusted Ruby, so she would tell

you this. It looked majestical! It was made entirely out of coral. It


had feisty fish guarding the door. There were loads of gems, jewels and diamonds spread all over the place!
