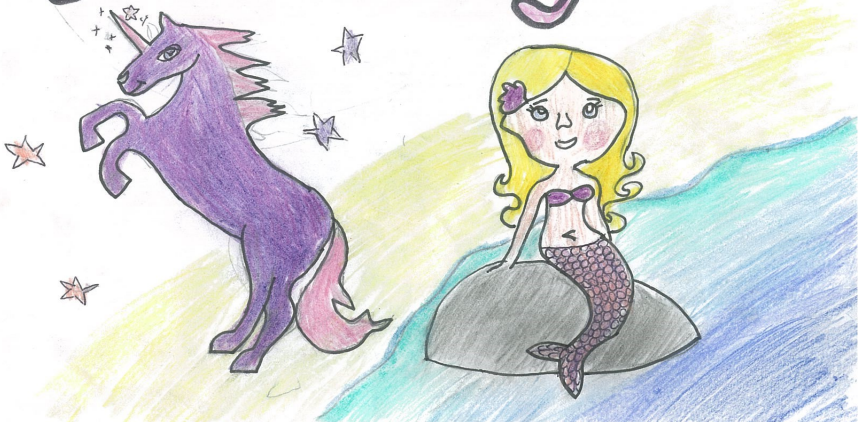


Lola and Fluffy Save The Day

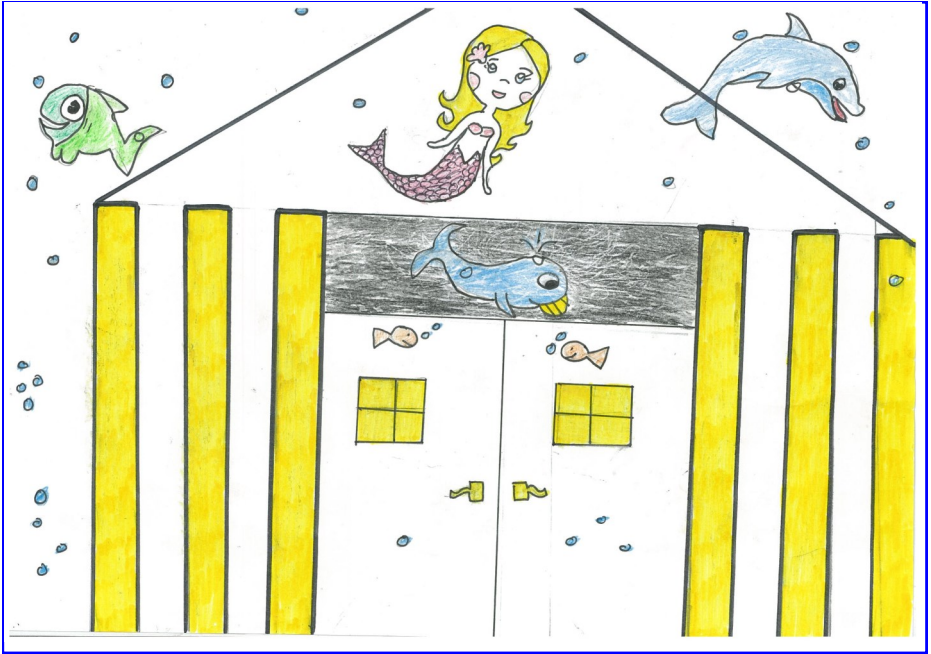

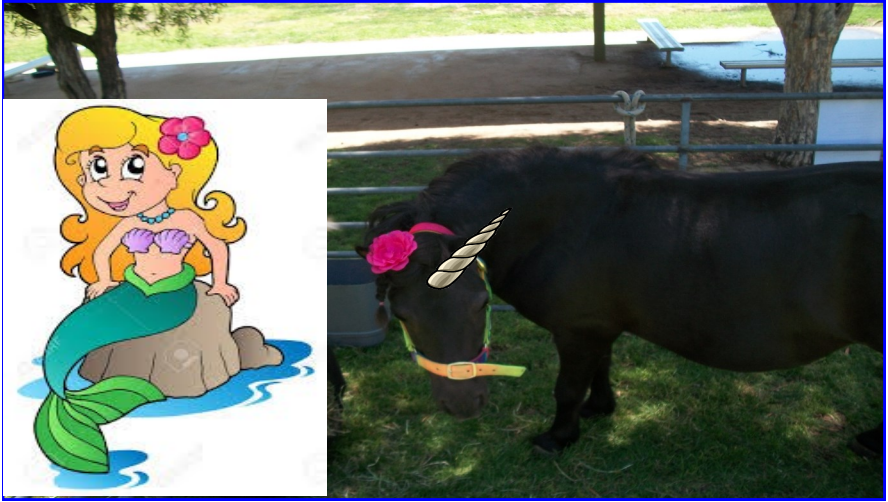
