### New DEC Model of Funding-Implications at North

In the past week I have received from the DEC the school's funding allocation in several areas for 2015.

The allocations in some of these sections have increased , whilst in others the allocation has fallen.

Over the past few years the school has been fortunate enough to receive funding to help parents/carers and the students. This was once called CAP funding and as an example, it enabled students to visit Canberra for \$300 instead of \$500.

Under the new funding model that has been introduced this year, there has been a substantial decrease in this aspect of funding at North.

As such, the impact on the school's ability to assist families with the cost of major excursions , buses and visiting performances, is significant.

Despite this sizeable cut in funding, there is one thing that will remain constant- the teachers, P&C and staff at our little 'school on a hill' shall remain , as ever, committed to providing the best possible opportunities and learning, for our greatest assets-our kids.

Presentations begin at 11am at the Deni RSL and student transport will be by private car as arranged by the Principal.


# Thanks to Federal Government
