NAPLAN Assessments

Students in years 3 and 5 are now halfway through their NAPLAN assessments and have maintained a positive attitude to the online assessment platform even when technical difficulties have occurred. Students are still amazed that all the schools in Australia are sitting the tests at the same time.

Homework Policy Changes

Last week at the parent session there were many questions around the changes to the homework policy and that it is no longer compulsory. Schools are required to develop homework guidelines that reflect this change and clearly communicate their stance on providing homework. These guidelines should be relevant to the needs of students and should be created in consultation with key stakeholders, including staff, parents or carers, and students. Feedback is being taken initially from parents through the survey below and from the feedback from the meet the teacher night.

Harmony Day and World Down Syndrome Day





Judge's choice








