Harmony Day

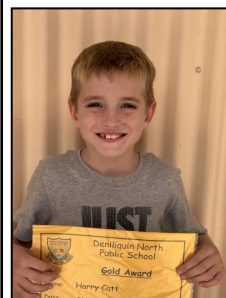
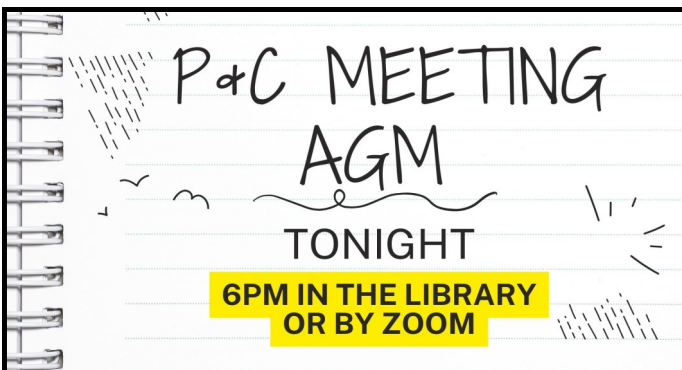

The categories for Easter hats are:

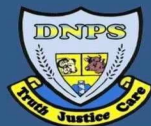
- Best 'own creation' (made by the child)

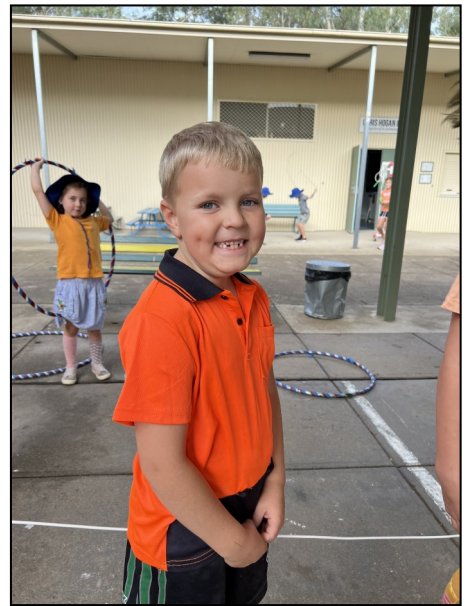

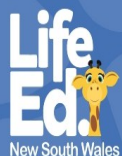
